

Please make sure you have either called into the telephone number provided or “Use Mic and Speakers” to listen to the webinar through your computer speakers (if available).




Zoom Webinar Control Panel Guide

- **Attendee Controls** — As an attendee, you can mute/unmute your audio, virtually raise your hand, and send messages to others.



- **Audio Settings** — Audio Settings (only visible if the host hasn't granted you permission to talk): Change your audio settings. You can also click the upward arrow (^) next to change your speaker.
- **Question & Answer Pane** — Open the Q&A window, allowing you to ask questions to the host and panelists. They can either reply back to you via text in the Q&A window or answer your question live. Type your question and click **Send** to submit it to the organizer.
 - The host can also answer your question live (out loud). You will see a notification in the Q&A window if the host plans to do this.
- **Leave Meeting** — Click Leave meeting to leave the webinar at any time. If you leave, you can rejoin if the webinar is still in progress, until the host has locked the webinar.



What is Wayfinding?



The ability to navigate a Town is vitally important to its economic prosperity. Visitors to a community need to be able to orient, find local services and points of interest, and feel that they can safely travel to their destination by whatever mode (transit, automotive, bicycle or pedestrian) selected.



Project Goals

- Design signage and wayfinding that helps residents and visitors be able to orient, find local services and points of interest and feel that they can safely travel to their destination by whatever mode (transit, automotive, bicycle or pedestrian) selected.
- Develop a design guideline and standards document for the Town that clearly identifies all potential wayfinding signage location, finalized signage design including specifications, material selection, and potential manufacturing options.










